### Annex 3 - Monitoring and Evaluation of the DMX

The DMX will only be useful if updated as often as is necessary to provide for relevant, timely information. In the case of Belize this can be extremely challenging since there is no specific mechanism for managing donor activity on the ground. The donor situation is extremely fluid and the experiences in the preparation of this report suggests that unless there is an established, recognized focal point for donor activity related to PSD, the updating process will be fragmented and may be incomplete.

If this limitation is overcome, then the recommended baseline of indicators for future monitoring and evaluation of the DMX for Belize is as follows:
